### ***CONFERENCE INFORMATION***

#### **Conference Registration** *(must be received by March 10, 2010)*

- The cost for one attendee is **\$2,195.00**.
- The cost for two attendees sharing a room is **\$1,795.00 each**.
- The cost for a guest staying in your room, not attending the conference classes or meals during the day, but attending the evening events is **\$450.00**.
- The conference fee covers all expenses except your transportation to San Antonio, your cost for the shuttle or taxi to and from the airport and your evening meal on Tuesday ("On Your Own" night).
- Registration forms and payment must be received by **MARCH 10, 2010**. No refunds after March 10.

**Prepaid Registrations:** If your registration was prepaid with your support fee, we offer a 50% refund (or 50% credit on your account for next year) if you notify us prior to March 10, 2010.

After March 10, 2010 there will be no refunds or credits.

#### **Conference Schedule**

### Travel Schedule

- Please **arrive** in San Antonio by **3:00 PM on April 11** in order to have time to get to the hotel and be ready for our tour / dinner on Sunday evening beginning at 6:00 PM. We want you to be a part of the fun event we have planned!
- Plan your **departure** on the **morning of April 15**.

### Airport Transfers / Parking (Downtown San Antonio)

Your destination is **THE HOTEL CONTESSA at 306 West Market St.**

- Fly in to San Antonio International Airport.
- You may take the **SATRANS Express Shuttle** to the **downtown** area. Cost is \$18 one way or \$32 for a round trip ticket. The shuttle runs every 15 minutes. Tickets may be purchased online at [www.sanantonio.gov/Aviation/downtownsuttle.asp](http://www.sanantonio.gov/Aviation/downtownsuttle.asp). They may also be purchased in the baggage area.
- You may take a taxi or city bus to downtown.  
Taxi = \$25 one way + tip
- You will **not** need a car in San Antonio. The hotel is located on the Riverwalk and within a few blocks of many restaurants, shops and things to do. There are several options for local transportation available.

**Parking for those driving to San Antonio:** The hotel offers valet overnight parking at \$28 + tax and tip. There are two garages within a block that charge \$12 - \$15 for overnight parking. The fee is more if you leave and return during a 24-hour period. For location and more information about these garages, please contact Lynne.
